
Commuters

The service from Crowborough Station this winter has been unacceptable. I will join Nus Ghani (our Parliamentary Candidate) in raising the matter at the highest levels and lobbying Network Rail & Southern to provide longer trains which run on time. Car parking also needs to be improved with more spaces created for commuters especially in the event of additional houses being built in the area. I am increasingly concerned over the reduction of bus services and the impact this will have on residents getting out and about in the Town.



Road Safety

The junction at the Cross, narrow pavements and increasing levels of fast moving traffic are causing concern along many of our roads. Safety measures are needed to reduce the number of injured and killed on Crowborough roads.



Supporting facilities for the youth of Crowborough

I am actively involved in supporting facilities for young people in Crowborough. As the Chair of the Town Council Sport, Recreation and Cemetery committee I have worked with the local skaters on the upgrading of the skate park at Goldsmiths. I have been lobbying East Sussex County Council to provide youth workers for a local youth club.

Crowborough Hospital

I fully support the retention of the War Memorial Hospital, Birthing Centre and Minor Injury Unit under the Maidstone and Tunbridge Wells NHS Trust. As a local resident I have relied on the local Hospital. I fully understand the need for these services to be retained locally and will always campaign for them to be maintained for the residents of Crowborough. In addition to this I will lobby to reintroduce day care facilities for both the elderly and disabled within the Town and push for greater clinical use of the hospital.
