Jo also leads the town on the Town Centre improvement team and was a founder member of the drive to reinstate a market in our market town.


Jo supports working with our young people giving them help and support while still in education and then through the successful Hailsham Works program.




Richard is married to Susan and has lived in Hailsham for over 30 years. During that time he ran a successful business on the High Street before deciding he wanted to do more for the community.

It was his concern to preserve the rural character around south Hailsham and also to help in the regeneration of the town centre, that caused him to get involved, and why he wants to continue the fight as your local councillor. He has participated in the Streets Ahead project towards High Street regeneration of Hailsham and Wealden. He helped research into Public Access Defibrillators (for treatment of heart attacks) which will result in four of these machines being installed in Hailsham, alongside public training in first aid. He was also chairman of the Finance, Budget and Resources committee in the Town Council and ensured that vital projects in Hailsham, such as the Hailsham Works project for young people and the new public toilets were realised.

Chriss would like to continue contributing towards improvements in the Town and District life.
